BACKGROUND INFORMATION

When the current Digby Regional High School (DRHS) was built the community, Nova Scotia Sport And Recreation Commission, The Town of Digby, and the Municipality of the District of Digby contributed a total of \$400,000.00 towards the construction of the Theatre.

As a result of these contributions, DRHS was designated as a "Community School".

In June of 2001, a legal agreement was signed between the Municipality of the District of Digby, the Town of Digby (represented by the Digby Area Recreation Commission) and the Southwest Regional School Board. This agreement, in essence, identifies DRHS including its outside amenities which will be available for community use in accordance with the agreement.

The Committee set up to administer the agreement is called the "Community Use of Schools' Policy Committee" and is comprised of five (5) representatives: two (2) appointed by the Tri-County Regional School Board, two (2) appointed by the Digby Area Recreation Commission and one (1) person as a non-voting chairperson who is selected by the Digby Area Recreation Commission and the Tri-County Regional School Board annually on a rotating basis.

This Committee may appoint additional resource people, i.e. Principal, Recreation Manager, CEO, etc. as deemed appropriate, in a non-voting capacity.

DRHS & Community Use Of Schools

A WORD ABOUT RATES:

Rates are set by the Committee and reviewed each year. When rates are set, several items are taken into consideration:

- That the health and safety of users is paramount.
- That Union Collective Agreements must be respected.
- Rental rates should be as reasonable as possible.
- That the Tri-County Regional School Board has an obligation to ensure that school property is used in a proper manner.

INSURANCE

Existing school board liability coverage provides school boards with the desired protection associated with community access to school facilities. This means that community groups and / or individual members of the public do not have to have proof of insurance prior to renting school facilities. Groups or individuals should check with their insurance provider for additional coverage.

SUMMARY OF RATES AND TIMES:	
WEEKDAY RATES	
Theatre / Music Room	\$25 per night or \$10 per hour
Gymnasium	\$25 per night or \$10 per hour
Classroom / Boardroom	\$5 per night
Cafeteria	\$10 per night
Lobby	\$5 per night
WEEKEND RATES	
Theatre / Music Room	\$135 per night
Gymnasium	\$95 per night
Classroom / Boardroom	\$30 per night
Cafeteria	\$60 per night
Lobby	\$40 per night

PLEASE NOTE:

If a full theatre production is held during the weekdays, it is then billed out at the weekend rate.

SECURITY: If required, will be billed at \$12 per hour.

TECHNICIANS: If required will be billed out at \$18 per hour. Renters will negotiate with the technician (prior to the event) for the time required. Contracts for technicians can be obtained from the office at DRHS.

WEEKEND CLEANING FEES: Will be billed at \$24 per hour (3 hour minimum).
